We would like to welcome all of you to an exciting year.

1st Day of classes is Monday August 8th!

- We would like to extend a cordial invitation to **MEET THE TEACHER DAY** before school starts on **Friday August 5, 2022 from 2:00p.m. to 3:30p.m.** We ask that you please bring in all the forms needing to be filled out on this day. We will be handing out student backpacks and chrome books at this time. We look forward to seeing you on this day as we will be ready to answer any questions you might have before the school year starts.
- Our first day of school will be on the **8th of August**. We will no longer begin our first day of school with a welcome back ceremony in the cafeteria as this is critical time for teachers and students to spend within the classroom. Our K-2 students can be dropped off in the cafeteria in which teachers will come pick up and 3rd- 8th grade students may walk to their classrooms when they hear the bell. We will have an assembly during the day for students ONLY.
- Our daily school schedule will be **Monday through Thursday from 7:50a.m. to 2:20p.m.** for Kinders and **Monday through Thursday from 7:50a.m. to 3:30p.m.** for 1st – 8th grade. Please make sure your child arrives to school on time every day. Attendance is very important in helping your child succeed academically.
- **Backpacks.** Students in grades Kinder – 2nd grade may bring a backpack of their choice. Students in grades 3rd – 8th grade may only bring a clear backpack to school. It is recommended that at the beginning of the school year you buy a couple as it is harder to find as the year progresses and your child's backpack tears.
- **Attendance.** It is very important to make sure your child is on time to school every day and present. Research states that students that attend school regularly do much better in their studies. We

understand that emergencies happen and that children do get sick and will be absent. We do ask that if your child has a fever, is throwing up, has severe cough and/or has diarrhea that you please keep them home. We are continuing to ensure the safety of all students and staff. If your child will be absent, please call the office at 520-287-0737.

- **Red Shirts.** We have Spirit Days every Thursday. Your child may wear their red on Thursdays to show Little Red Pride!
- **Headphones/Ear Buds.** Please purchase a set of earbuds/headphones for your child to use with the Chromebook provided by the school. The school is not responsible for stolen/damaged/lost electronic pieces and we ask that you take this into consideration when making the purchase for your child.
- **Staff Changes:** We are excited to have Mrs. Danitza Garcia join our Title 1 department this year as the instructional Title 1 Aide and to have Ms. April Granillo as a Reading instructional aide in the classrooms along with Ms. Dulce Alvarez as the Math instructional aide. It is our goal to make sure each child gets their academic needs met.
- **School Lunches.** We will continue to provide free breakfast and lunches for all students. Students may also bring a lunch from home. Students will be able to continue to warm up their own lunches this school year. Lunches must already be cooked and ready for heating up as it only heats for 30 seconds to avoid students from getting burned. The microwaves will be allowed to be used by those students that sign a consent form (form to be send out once school starts).
- **Pick-Up Students** must be picked up promptly by the gate and by the parent/guardian or authorized person as stated in the form you fill out the first day of school. If your child is not at the gate please **keep moving**, traffic tends to stop and cars line up all the way to the freeway causing the possibility of accidents. You may park at the front parking lot and pick up your child by the gate or if staying in your vehicle, please keep moving your car until your child comes to the gate.
- **Birthday/celebration Reminders.** It is our commitment at our school to provide the best academic education we can offer to your children. Our school days are very busy, filled up with academic activities; therefore, we will not be permitting Birthday parties during the year in the classrooms. We **do not permit birthday celebrations** on school field trips either. These are important child events and should be celebrated at home.
- **Electronics/Cell phones.** Any electronic devices and/or cellphone use by students is not permitted on campus, on the school buses, or at Little Red School Activity Events. Please keep all electronic devices at home or **they will be taken away**.
